Protected Area Planning and Management Specialist

Cape Verde, a small insular and archipelagic country, exposed to economic and environmental vulnerabilities, requires appropriate strategies for the management of the nation's natural resources. Cape Verde has ratified the Convention on Biological Diversity in 1995 and in 1999 drafted the national strategy and action plan on Biodiversity. On 24 February 2003 the Decree-Law No. 3/2003 on the legal regime of natural areas was published, which creates 47 protected areas, subdivided into 6 categories: national park, Natural Park, natural reserves, protected landscape, natural monument and sites of scientific interest.

In this context the Government of Cape Verde has obtained funding from the Global Environment Facility (GEF) and United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) to implement a project entitled "Consolidation of Cape Verde's Protected Area System". The project has the following objective:

"To consolidate and strengthen Cape Verde's protected areas (PA) System through the establishment of new terrestrial and marine PA units and the promotion of participatory approaches to conservation"
